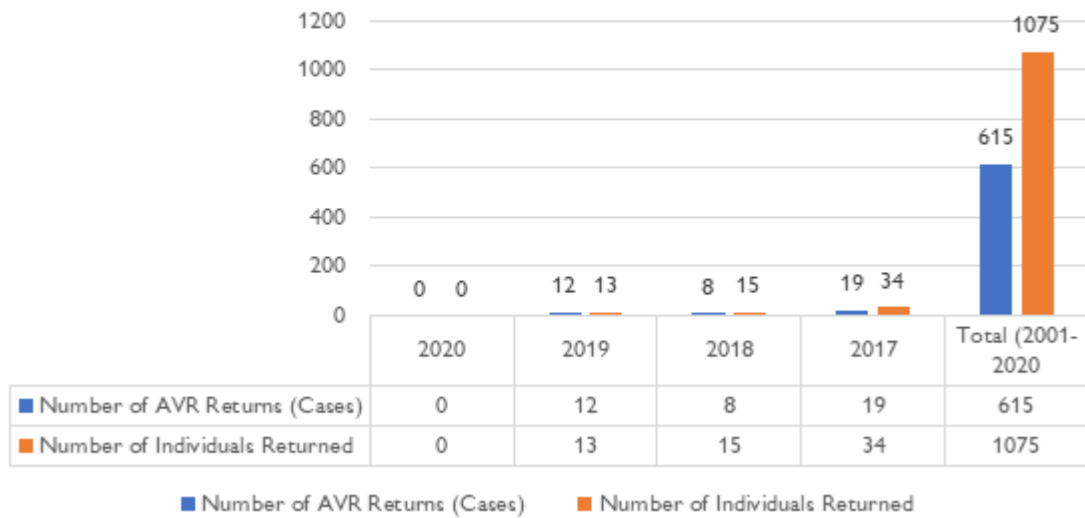

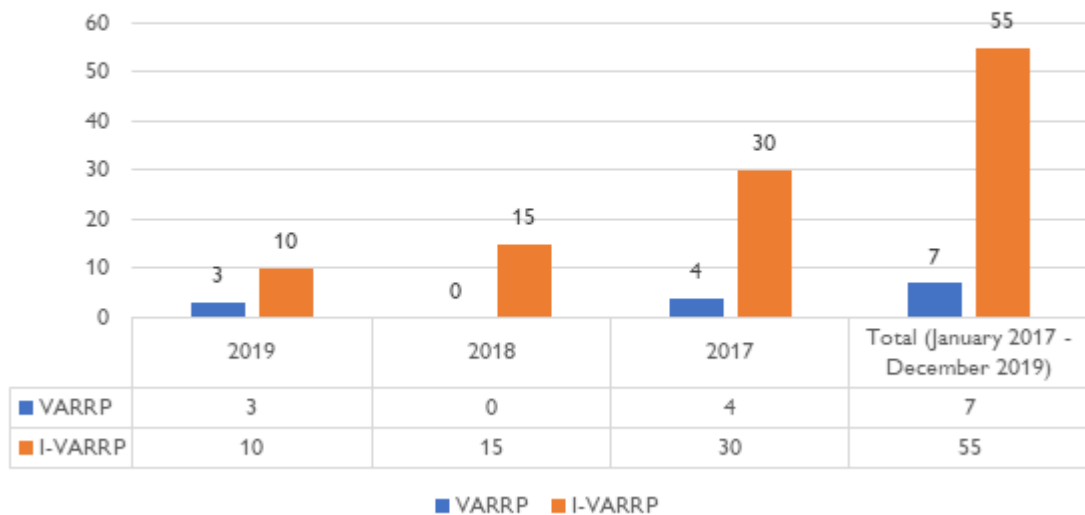

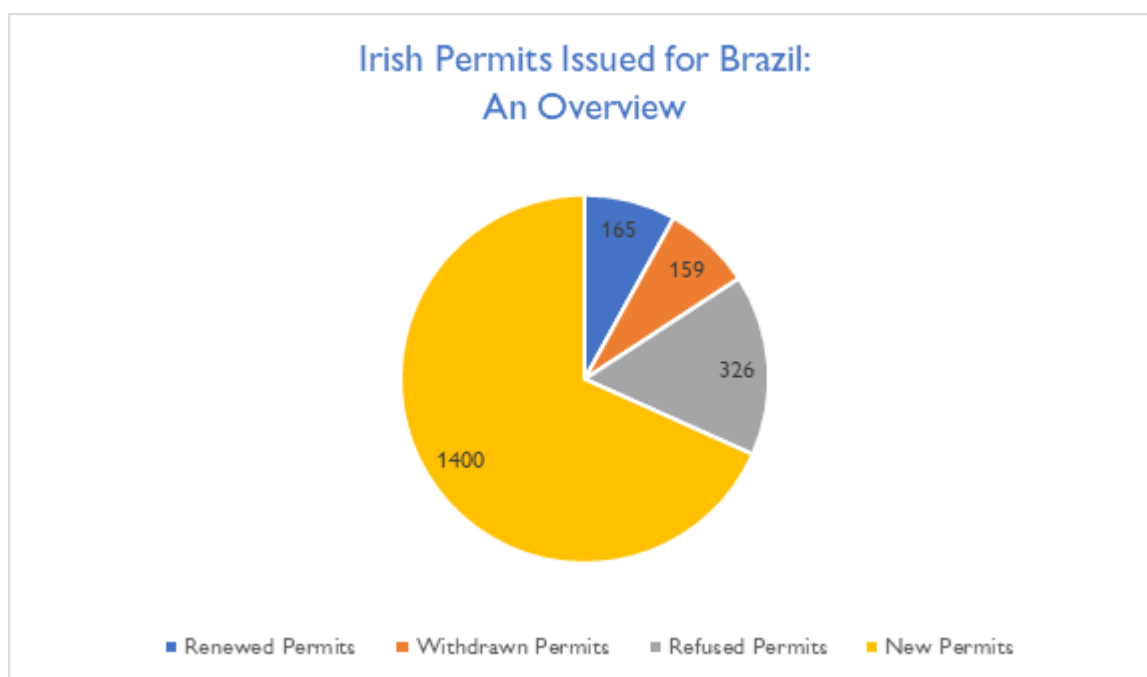

Brazil | Permits in Ireland (2019)



- In 2019, 1400 new permits were issued to Brazilian nationals in Ireland. 165 permits were renewed during this year, 326 permits were refused, and 159 permits were withdrawn; amounting to a total of 1565 permits for 2019 overall.⁶

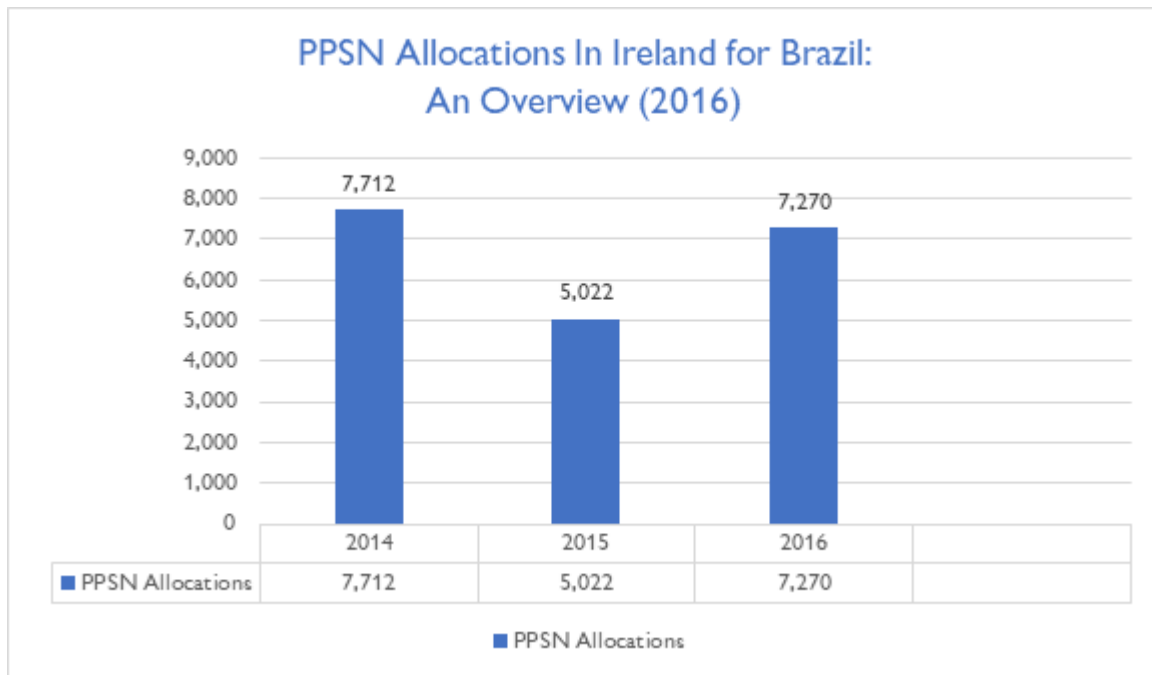
